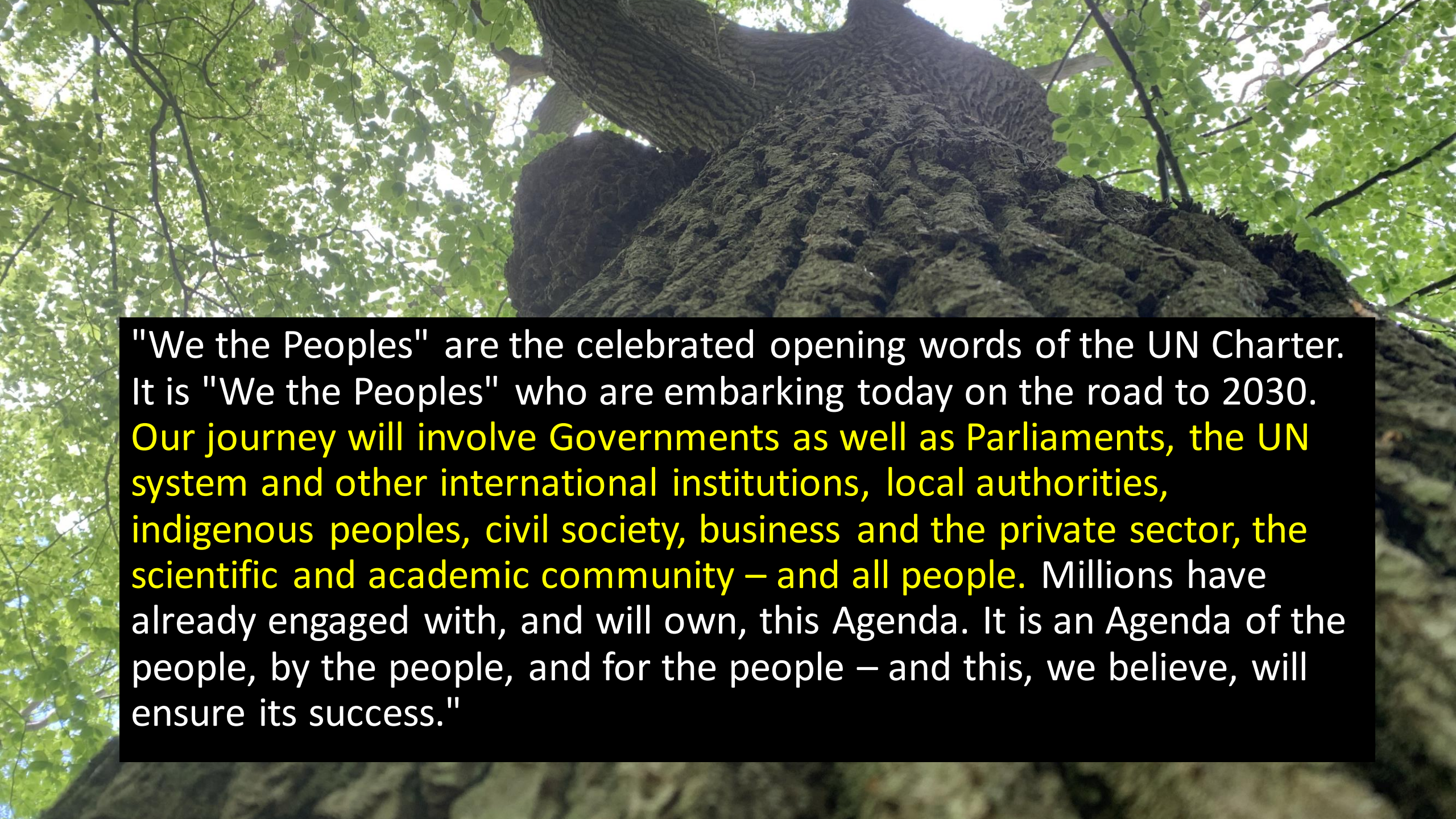

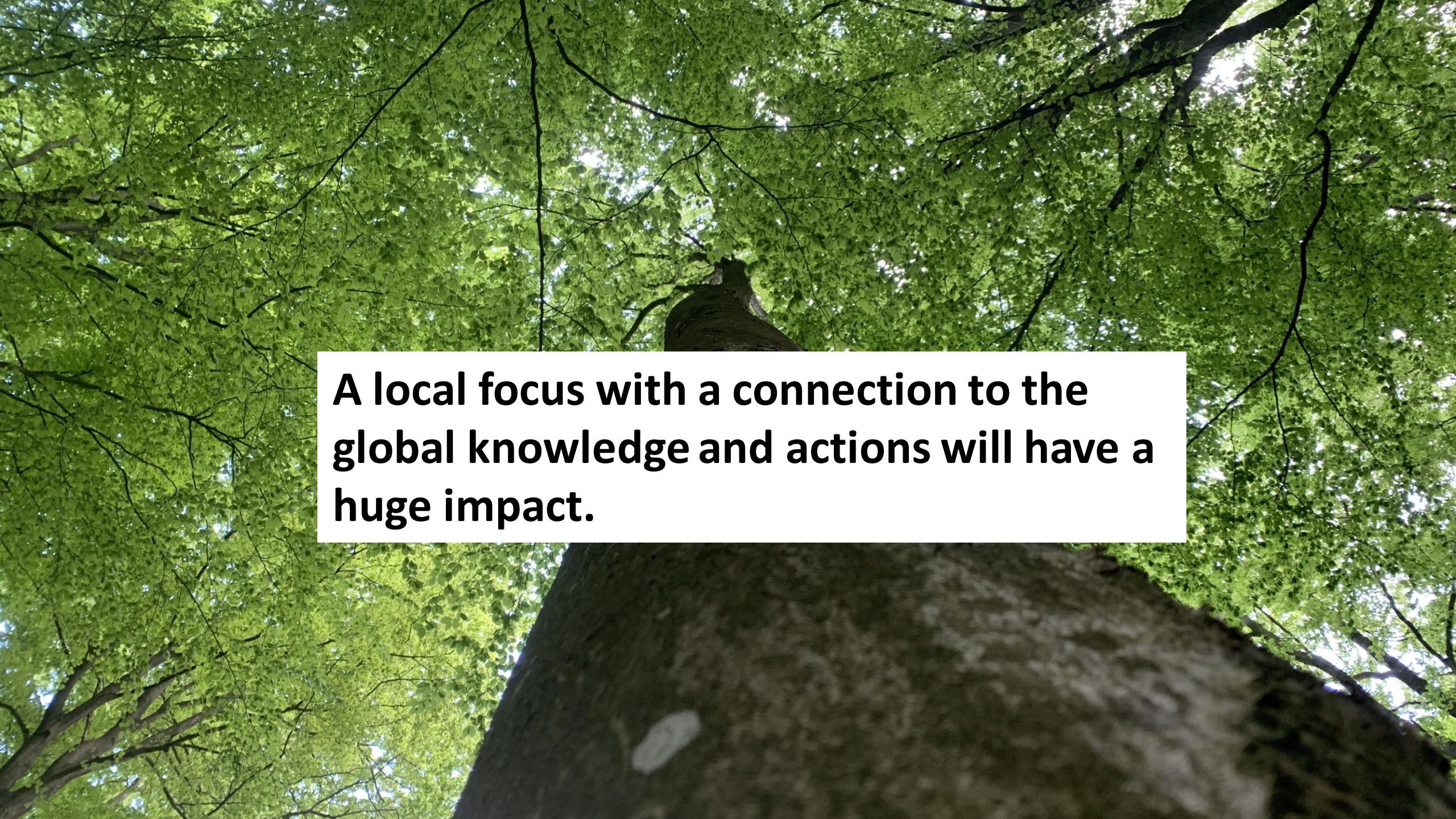

The Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) provide a comprehensive framework for addressing global challenges and promoting sustainable development. While the SDGs encompass a wide range of issues, they also indirectly support small businesses in several ways.



Economic Growth and Decent Work (SDG 8):

SDG 8 aims to promote sustained, inclusive, and sustainable economic growth, full and productive employment, and decent work for all.
